

# School Uniform For All Levels

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**New Marist uniform items are to be purchased from Elizabeth Michael only.**

<b>Jackets</b>	Official Marist monogrammed sports jacket.
<b>Scarves</b>	Official Marist school scarf or plain black or navy scarf.
<b>Sun Hat</b>	Optional.
<b>PE Uniform</b>	Marist shorts and sports shirt (two styles available - sleeveless and cap sleeve) The sleeveless PE shirt is required for most team sports.
<b>Sports Uniform</b>	Sleeveless PE shirt and school ankle length navy socks are required for most sports teams.
<b>Marist tracksuit</b>	Optional. Students selected for top sports teams are required to wear Marist tracksuit to and from games and at National Tournaments.

## School Uniform Requirements Year 7-11

<b>Blouse</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> White short sleeved summer Marist blouse. <b>Terms 2 &amp; 3 (Winter)</b> White long sleeved winter Marist blouse.
<b>Skirt</b>	Choice of Marist navy ankle or knee length skirts.
<b>Trouser</b>	Marist navy trouser (optional).
<b>Cardigan</b>	Marist navy cardigan.
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain black sturdy leather school shoes (no pumps, fashion shoes, fancy buckles or laces, converse, chucks or vans—type shoes).
<b>Sandals</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> Black roman sandals (from any shoe shop) or black “safari” sandals from Elizabeth Michael only. Sandals must be worn without socks. Please contact the school if special shoes are necessary.
<b>Socks</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> Plain navy Marist ankle socks.
<b>Stockings/Socks</b>	<b>Terms 2 &amp; 3 (Winter)</b> Plain navy Marist ankle or knee length socks, or plain black opaque tights.
<b>School Blazer</b>	<b>Year 11/12/13 only.</b>

## School Uniform Requirements Year 12

<b>Blouse</b>	Year 12/13 lemon/white fine striped Marist blouse.
<b>Skirt</b>	Choice of Marist navy ankle or knee length skirts.
<b>Trouser</b>	Marist navy trouser (optional).
<b>School Blazer</b>	Navy with gold stripe Marist blazer.
<b>Cardigan</b>	Navy Marist cardigan.
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain black sturdy leather school shoes (no pumps, fashion shoes, fancy buckles or laces).
<b>Sandals</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> Black roman sandals (from any shoe shop) or black ‘safari’ sandals from Elizabeth Michael only. Sandals must be worn without socks. Please contact the school if special shoes are necessary.
<b>Socks</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> Plain navy Marist ankle socks.
<b>Stockings/Socks</b>	<b>Terms 2 &amp; 3 (Winter)</b> Plain navy Marist ankle or knee length socks, or plain black opaque tights.

## School Uniform Requirements Year 13

<b>Blouse</b>	Year 12/13 lemon/white fine striped Marist blouse.
<b>School Blazer</b>	Navy with gold stripe Marist monogrammed.
<b>Skirt</b>	Navy Marist skirt, ankle length (for official occasions).
<b>Trouser</b>	Marist navy trouser (optional).
<b>Tie, Vest &amp; Cardigan</b>	Navy, Marist monogrammed.
<b>Shoes</b>	Plain black polished leather shoes with backs (no slides). Flat heeled - no high heels (at Dean’s discretion).
<b>Sandals</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> Black leather, back strapped, flat heeled i.e. roman sandals (no slave or fashion sandals). Please check with your Dean if you are unsure.
<b>Socks</b>	<b>Terms 1 &amp; 4 (Summer)</b> Plain navy Marist ankle socks.
<b>Stockings/Socks</b>	<b>Terms 2 &amp; 3 (Winter)</b> Plain navy Marist ankle or knee length socks, or plain black opaque tights.

## Notes

- The uniform should be clean, neat and tidy.
- All skirts must be neatly hemmed and correctly worn.
- Shoes should be clean and polished.
- Sandals are worn without socks.
- Previous uniform cardigan and jacket items are permitted to be worn until 2021.
- Make-up and Nail varnish are not permitted.
- Shoulder length/long hair is to be tied back. Hair ties must be navy, black or white. (no bows or fancy clips). Plaited braids must be tied back. Hair should be of a natural colour. Hair extensions, wraps, dreadlocks and inappropriate cuts/style are not permitted (all at Principal's discretion).
- The ONLY jewellery permitted is a wristwatch and one small pair of plain gold, silver or coloured stud can be worn in each lower earlobe (no bling, pearls or sleepers).
- No puffer jackets allowed.
- All clothing and bags must be clearly named.
- Three uniform infringements in a term, without a note, will result in a detention.
- Only one piercing in the lower ear lobe of each ear is permitted. (No nasal piercings, eye brow or tongue piercings are permitted)
- No visible body adornment such as tattoos are permitted. Any cultural exceptions to this must approved by the Principal on a case by case basis.

The College encourages pride in appearance and personal grooming. The correct regulation school uniform should be worn at ALL times when students are travelling to and from the College as well as during the school day.
